Are you a healthy, right-handed adult between the ages of 18 and 35? You may qualify to participate in a research study!

The ONRC is currently looking for individuals between the ages of 18 and 35 with relatives who have alcoholism or a history of alcoholism

to participate in a research study.

What does the study involve?

- The research study consists of four separate days: one 4 hour screening visit as well as three research visits each lasting approximately 7 hours. Each research visit you will be administered either a placebo, 50 mg dose of Saracatinib or 125 mg dose of Saracatinib. Saracatinib has been used in previous research studies, but is the same type of drug expected to play a role in alcoholism therapy.
- Participants will be compensated at a rate of \$20 per hour for the time it takes to complete the study, plus given the opportunity to win more money on computerized tasks.
